TREATMENTS, EVOCATIONS AND BENEDICTIONS

Evocations and Benedictions differ from treatments. In treatments we consciously use the Law, and release our word that it may manifest. Since God is present in all who are in the class (meeting, etc.) the Evocation simply awakens the awareness of the Presence of God. We do not release our word since we haven't spoken our word for the purpose of manifestation.

In the Benediction, we give thanks for the Presence of God during the activity of the class (meeting), and give a blessing for all as they depart and return to their individual lives. We do not release our word, as we have not spoken our word for the purpose of manifestation. Following are explanations to share with the class.

Opening Evocation: Invite those present to be still and receptive. Invite an awareness of the presence of God in those present. Invite the expression of God in and through all present, in all Its fullness, peace, power and love. Give thanks in advance for the good to be received and shared during the class (meeting, Practitioner session, etc.)

Opening Treatment: Takes the form of a regular treatment (5 steps). It is used when some need exists within the group for divine guidance, inspiration, unification or healing. Action is sought. Release anything limiting the activity of the group, individually or collectively. Give thanks and release your word as in any treatment.

Closing Benediction: Give thanks for the Presence of God during the time spent together, and for the accomplishments of the group. Give a blessing to accompany all, as they depart and go about their individual lives.

Closing Treatment: Takes the form of a regular treatment (5 steps). It is used when some need exists within the group to be unified, empowered or healed. Give thanks for the workings of Spirit through all individuals during the gathering and for the continued healing presence to go with them as they depart. Release any sense of separation within the group from Spirit. Give thanks for the desired action and release your word, as in any treatment.
